

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

Sept 3 continued:

-Heppner Ambulance received report of a 45-year-old female in Lexington complaining of chest pain and shortness of breath. The subject, who has severe asthma, was transported to Good Shepherd Hospital in Hermiston.

-Boardman Fire Department, Boardman Ambulance received report of a single-vehicle accident on I-84 near Boardman. The vehicle had blown a tire and a tow was called.

Sept. 4: -Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a 911 hang-up call from a Lexington residence. MCSO called back several times with static on the lines or a busy signal. Deputies responded.
