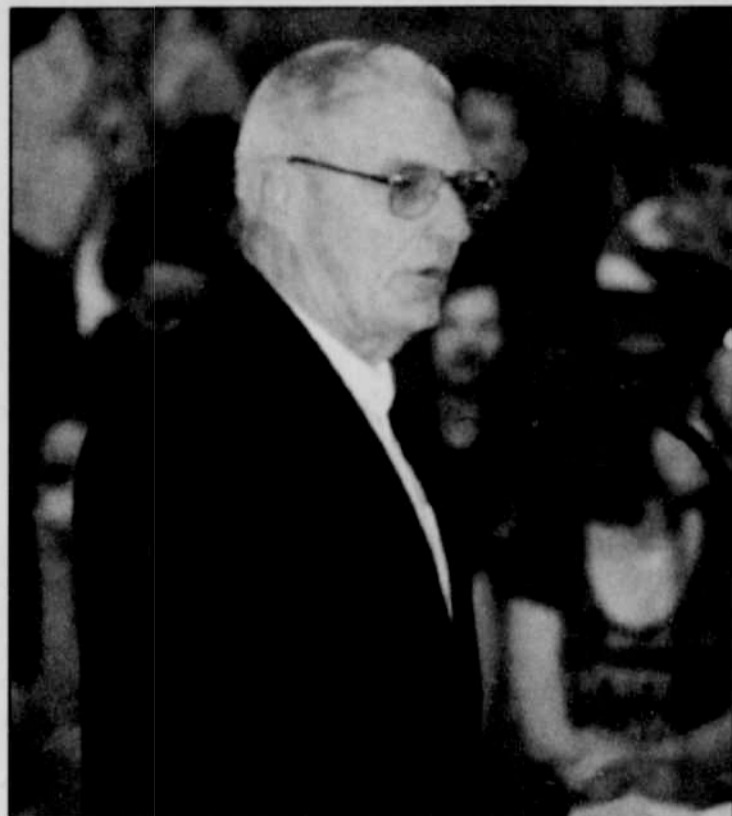


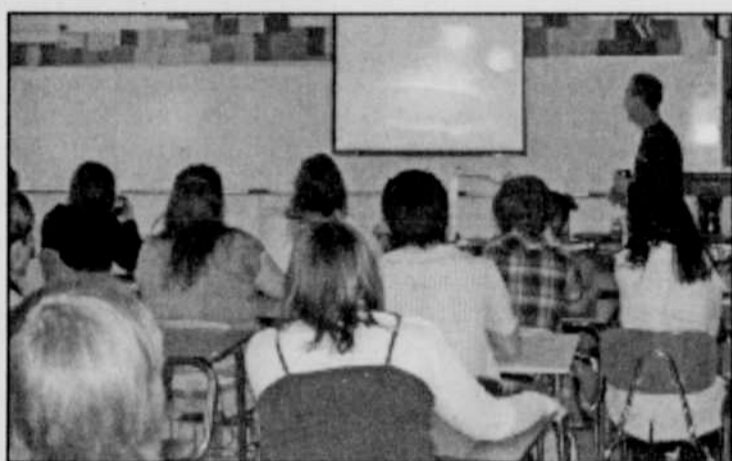
Veterans speak to HHS students



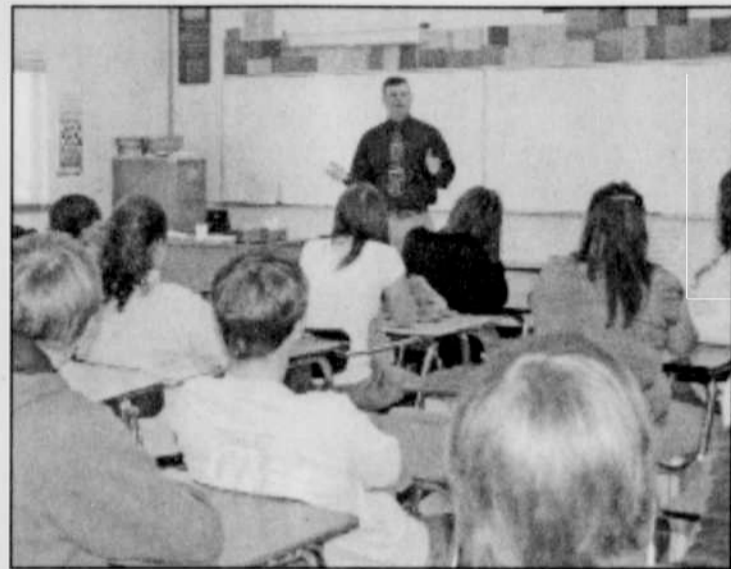
Jim Harmon - Guest Speaker, Vietnam



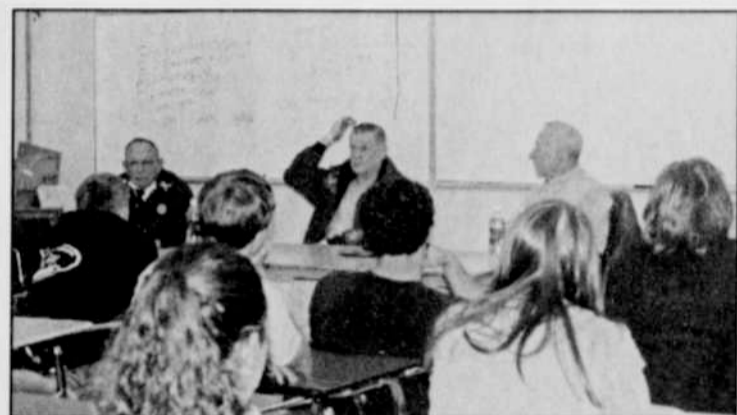

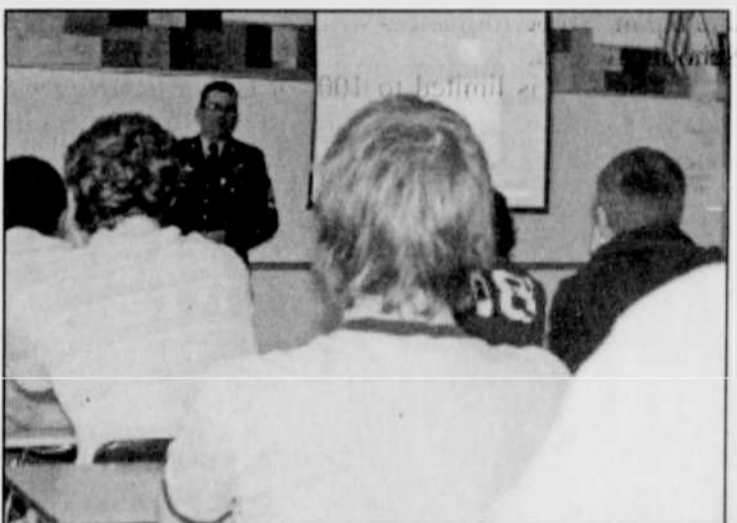
