

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

-MCSO received report of subjects angling in the river by Irrigon and camping. MCSO deputy advised they were angling only and could stay as long as they weren't camping.

-MCSO, Heppner Ambulance received report of a male down in a restroom lying against the door in Heppner. The subject was conscious and responsive.

-MCSO received report of the neighbor's dogs chasing chickens in Irrigon.

-MCSO received a call concerning a custody dispute in Irrigon. The subjects had a verbal dispute and requested deputy to file a report.

-MCSO cited Tiffany Raean Ober, 19, for VBR, 87 mph in a 65 mph zone.
