Heppner traveled to Enterprise on Friday, January 25. Heppner lead the game all night with a final score of HHS 65 Enterprise 42.

The first half was HHS 14 Enterprise 7, and at the halftime buzzer it was HHS 34 Enterprise 16. By the third quarter the boys had pulled away by 19 points, continuing their lead into the fourth with Mustangs taking the win.

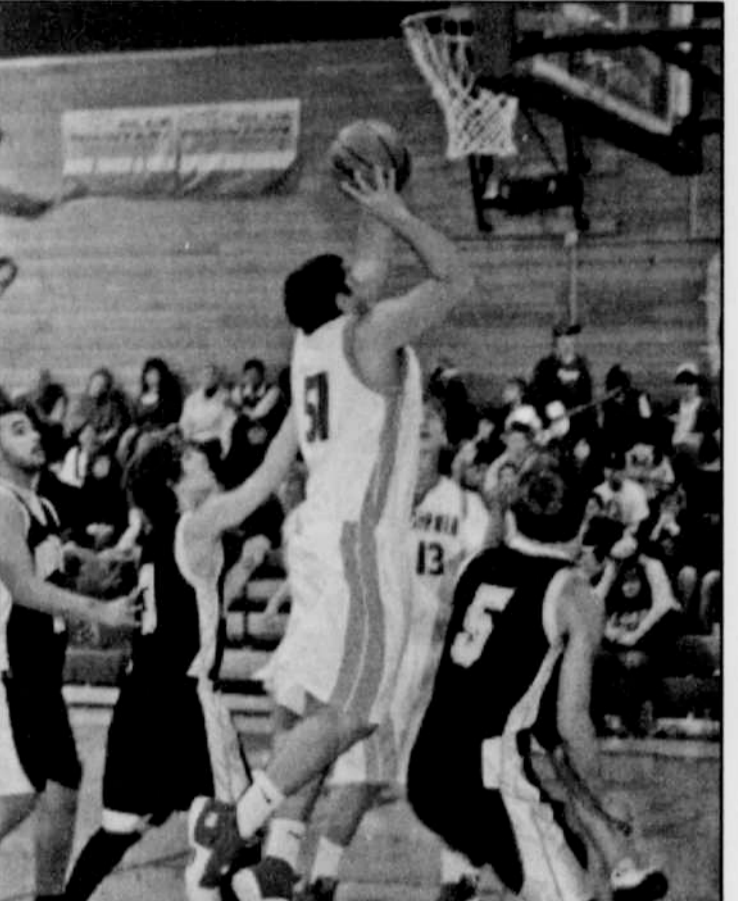
Lane Bailey sunk 13 for the night and Nacho Elguezabal with 11 points and 15 rebounds. Jared Huddleston, AJ Rauch and Braden Britt all had eight points. Chris Lien had seven, Brent Eckman and Nathan Van Cleave had four and Jordan Hatfield contributing two for the win. The Mustangs shot an outstanding 53% from the field.

On Saturday Heppner went on to Elgin for a win of 58 to 48.

Heppner never let the Huskies step ahead. In the first quarter the Mustangs were eight points ahead with Heppner 14, Elgin 6. By the half HHS had 22 points and Elgin had 16 points. In the third quarter the Mustangs held a seven point lead at 39-32. In the fourth quarter the Heppner pulled their lead to a 10 point spread to take the win.

Lane Bailey led the Mustangs with 18 points and Brent Eckman with 13, AJ Rauch put up 11 and Nathan Van Cleave and Nacho Elguezabal each had six. Chris Lien and Braden Britt also contributed two points each for the Mustangs win.

The following Friday Heppner greeted Union on the Mustang court. Heppner led the game by six points all thru the first three quarters. The fourth quarter the Bobcats caught up

Heppner was down by 3 points in the first quarter. By half-time the Mustangs were up 13 points over the Tiger-Scots and the Mustangs didn't let up. Their lead grew bigger in the third quarter with a 15 point gap. The final score was Heppner 49, Weston-McEwen 36.

AJ Rauch led the team with 14 points. Nacho Elguezabal sunk 10 and Lane Bailey shot seven for the night. Jared Huddleston had six, Brent Eck-

man put in five and Nathan Van Cleave had four. Bryan Holland had two and Braden Britt contributed one for the Mustang win.

With two days to rest Heppner went back out on the road to meet up with the Irrigon Knights.

In the first quarter the game was tied at 9. By the half time buzzer the Knights had pulled away by two points leaving a score of 22-24. In the third quarter the Mustangs came alive and took the lead by six points and ended the game with a win over Irrigon, with a final score of Mustangs 53 and Knights 41.

Jared Huddleston led the Mustangs with 22 points. AJ Rauch scored 10 and pulled down nine rebounds. Brent Eckman had nine points and six rebounds. Nathan Van Cleave and Nacho Elguezabal each scored four points. Chris Lien and Braden Britt each contributed two points with Braden Britt pulling down six rebounds also.
