

## Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

-Continued from Page eight given by the reporter.

-MCSO issued a citation to Tamar Lynn Johnson, 33, for violating the Speed Limit by going 87 mph in a 65 mph zone.

-MCSO deputy spoke to two males that had been sitting in a car for a long time.

-MCSO received a report from a female reporter who stated her father was harassing her and wants him charged for trespassing.

-BPD received a report regarding the removal of a large box of beer bottles left in the road.

-BPD issued a citation to Joel Mendoza Medrano, 47, for driving while suspended and failing to carry registration.

-BPD officer out with two vehicles that were possibly involved in an accident. The situation was determined that the two vehicles were just waiting for someone. The officer advised the subjects involved that it was not a good idea to be waiting at the intersection.

-BPD received a report that a female subject needed help getting into her car.
