

## Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

### February 27:

-MCSO, Boardman Police Dept., Umatilla Police Dept. received a report from a caller in Irrigon that an unknown female subject was at her house and acting strangely.
