The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

-MCSO received a report from a caller in Boardman that she had a patient that had her oxygen cord wrapped around her neck. A deputy responded and Behavioral Health was contacted.

-MCSO deputy cited Rachele L. M. Wenick, 22, for Violation of the Basic Rule, 70 mph in a 55 mph zone.

-MCSO received a report from a caller in Irri-gon that a male subject fixed her son's bike and now refuses to return it. Caller advised deputies she is pick-ing up the bike tomorrow.

-Boardman Police Dept. officer cited Michael Treva Jones, 50, for Failure to Carry Proof of Insur-ance.
