Along with the 4-H Snack Shack, outside will be Fernando's Mexican Food from Hermiston with delicious enchiladas, burritos, tacos, and much more.


MW Tropical Sno will be serving as the shaved ice vendor this year. Operator Ed Worthen is from Waterville, WA. Come out and have a cool treat.
