

### Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

**-MCSO, Boardman Police Department** received report from a minister in Boardman that a dog outside the church wasn't letting people out of their cars.

**-Boardman Police Department** arrested Daniel Hood, 37, for DUII. He was cited and released.

**-MCSO** arrested Christopher Michael Swope, 30, for assault IV domestic and harassment.

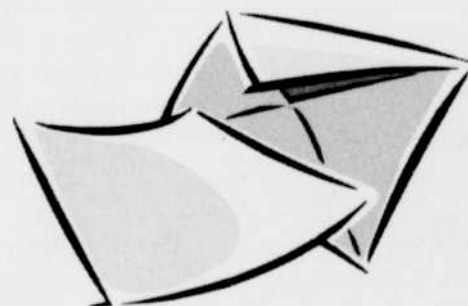
**-MCSO** arrested Carol Jean Klein, 66, for DUII and resisting arrest. Klein was also cited for refusing a breath test.
