

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

Dec. 25 cont.: Boardman Ambulance received a report of a 65 year old male with severe abdominal pain. Boardman Ambulance advised that they were stuck in the snow with a cardiac patient and needed immediate response. Devins' assisted the ambulance and the patient was transported.

Dec. 26: -MCSO issued a citation to Robert Clyde Robertson Jr., 41, for No Operator's License Accident and Failure to Carry Proof of Insurance Accident.

-BPD received a report of an assault in progress involving a 16 year old male who was out of control.

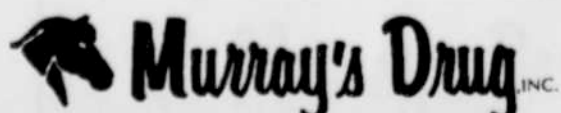
