T-8636 filed by Rusty Spur Ranch, LLC, PO Box 280, Heppner, OR 97836, proposes to change the point of appropriation under a portion of Permit G-12063. The portion of the permit to be affected by T-8636 allows the use of 0.42 cfs (priority date February 25, 1994) from a well in Sec. 7, T 2S, R 26E, W.M. (Willow Creek Basin) for irrigation of 33.6 acres in Sec. 7 and 8. The applicant proposes to move the point of appropriation to a well located approximately 2900 feet east (Sec. 7, T 2S, R 26E, W.M.) from the original point of appropriation.
