The Wrangler's Riding Club held their final double-header of the season on Sunday, May 3. Results are as follows:

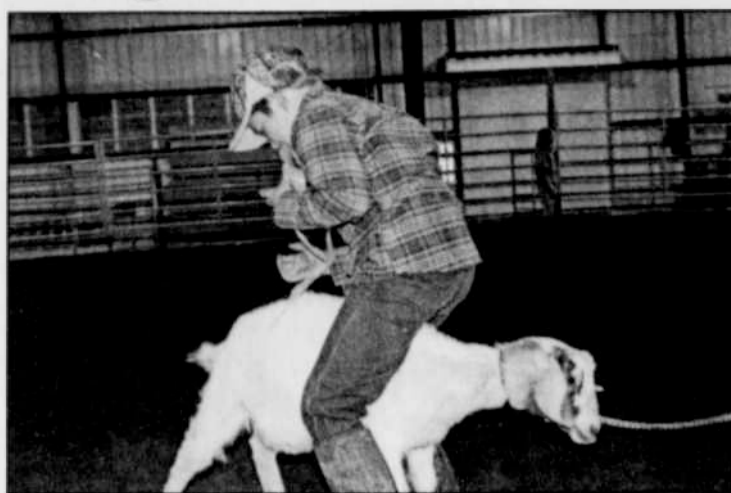

The Morrow County Court met on April 22 in Heppner with Judge Tallman, Commissioner Grieb and Commissioner Rea in attendance. Following is a summary of those meeting provided by Leann Rea.

The Court approved the following minutes: February 2, 2009, February 4, 2009, February 26, 2009 and March 4, 2009.

The court approved accounts payable and payroll in the amount of \$163,879.25.

The court conducted the following business: Appointed Commissioner Grieb to the Columbia-Blue Mountain Resource Conservation & Development Area (RC&D) Council, with Janet Greenup named as alternant; Appointed Melissa Dunn to the Morrow County Fair Board; Appointed Matt Combe to the Mental Health Advisory Board; Reviewed a letter from Wheatland In-

surance agent regarding the need to receive a Certificate of Liability from any vendor setting up business on county property prior to set-up, also if they will be serving alcohol they must provide the county with proof of Host Liquor Liability coverage; Reviewed the agenda for the Tuesday, April 28 Morrow County Planning Commission meeting; Reviewed and signed the Retirement Program Professional Services Agreement.

Following this meeting the court moved to the annex for the budget hearings which were held on the 22nd, 23rd and 24th of April.

On April 24 the court held a brief meeting to review and sign a letter of support for the Port of Morrow's application for federal funding for the newly proposed interchange in the area of the Hwy 730 and 184 interchange.

DA's Report

Morrow County District Attorney Elizabeth Ballard has released the following report:

-William Ellis Looney, 33, was convicted of attempt to commit a Class A felony (Arson-1), a Class B felony, and was sentenced to three years supervised probation and other numerous conditions. Looney was also convicted of criminal mischief in the second degree, a class A misdemeanor, and was sentenced to 24 months bench probation, complete 40 hours of community service and other numerous conditions. Total fines, fees and assessments were \$2,011.

-Travis Leroy Davis, 34, was convicted of possession of methamphetamine, a Class C felony, and was sentenced to five months in the custody of the Oregon Department of Corrections, one year post-prison supervision, other numerous conditions, and pay \$528 in fines, fees and assessments.
