

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

March 26 cont.:
-MCSO received a report from a subject in Boardman who said that his father met a female and the subject was trying to get her to leave but she wouldn't. Deputy advised it was a civil issue and they need to go the civil route to evict her
-MCSO received report from an Irrigon woman that the neighbor's turkeys were in her yard again. Deputy made contact

with the turkeys' owners, who have 20-30 wild turkeys.

-MCSO received a report from a subject in Boardman who advised that a female harassed him and made it impossible to do his paper route. He said that she was yelling at him that he owed her daughter money and when he said "no," she began pounding on the hood of his car. He said she followed him until he pulled into the police station.

-MCSO received report of two white dogs in Irrigon that injured a horse.

-MCSO received report from a subject in Lexington who said his fa-

ther had approximately 17 horses and several head of cattle that are not being fed properly. He said his dad was disabled and his step-mother refused to buy them feed. After the son reported the issue, there was hay on the lots.

-MCSO received report that Oregon State Police arrested Patrick Charles Donahue, 45, for Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle and Driving Under the Influence. He was lodged at Umatilla County Jail with \$13,500 bail.
