DA's Report

Morrow County District Attorney Elizabeth Ballard has released the following report:
-Scott Fredric

Freshner, 46, was convicted Falsifying Drug Test Results, a Class B misdemeanor reduced to a Class A violation, and was ordered to pay \$150 in fines, fees and assessments.

-Roberto Carlos Bernal Ruiz, 26, was convicted of Harassment,

a Class B misdemeanor, and was sentenced to 90 days incarceration with 90 days suspended, 18 months bench probation, 24 hours community service, other conditions, and pay \$361 in fines, fees and assessments.

-Donita Elaine Counsell, 33, was convicted of Possession of Methamphetamine, a Class C felony, and was sentenced to 90 sanction units with 30 jail units, 18 months supervised probation, complete 80 hours of community service, other conditions, and pay \$528 in fines, fees and assessments.

-Michael Anthony Mullikin, 25, was convicted of Contempt of Court and was sentenced to 180 days incarceration with 160 days suspended, 18 months bench probation, other conditions, and pay \$913 in fines, fees and assessments.

Martin was also convicted of two counts of Recklessly Endangering Another Person, a Class A misdemeanor and for each count was sentenced to 90 days incarceration with 90 days suspended, two years bench probation, and other conditions. Total fines, fees and assessments were \$1,883.

-Andrew Scott Gomez, 24, was convicted of Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree, a Class A misdemeanor, and was sentenced to 30 days incarceration with 30 days suspended, 12 months bench probation, other conditions, and pay \$433 in fines, fees and assessments.

-Ann Marie Brigeno, 31, was convicted of Contempt of Court and sentenced to 45 days incarceration with 30 days suspended, 12 months bench probation, other conditions, and pay \$578 in fines, fees and assessments.
