Thursday night slack will begin at 7 p.m., the NPRA rodeo will start at 7 p.m. on Friday night, and Saturday night events will also begin at 7 p.m. On Friday and Saturday, Mutton Bustin' will begin at 6:30 p.m. This year's clown bull fighter will be Tracy Reed.
