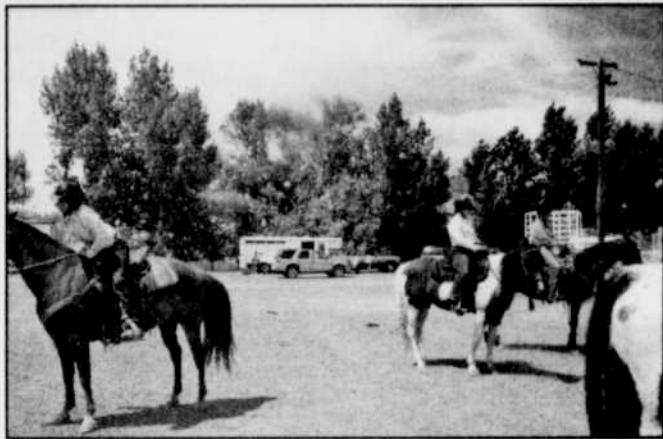


4-H members kick off fair and rodeo week
