

**Sheriff's Report**

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

-BPD advised subjects not to rev their engines again or they would be cited again.

-BPD received report of a dog caught on camera chasing kids. The owner was warned against maintaining a dog as a nuisance or they would be ticketed.

-BPD received a 911 call from a Boardman address. The subjects said they were trying to set up a computer and called 911 by accident.

-BPD received report of a cold burglary of two city shops on Marine Drive.
