-Continued from Page ONE where the crosses came from. McCurry has been in the Army for 18 years and this will be his third deployment. He is the son of Dave and Judy McCurry of Lakeview. He and his wife, Tiffany, have two children, Gibson, 9, and Tresslyn, 7. Since DeSpain began making his handmade wooden crosses he has given away approximately 25,000, with 7,000-8,000 being given to servicemen. DeSpain and his wife, Aloha, do not accept money for the crosses, but instead direct donations to Ascension School in Cove for camp scholarships for kids. A deployment ceremony will be held on Saturday, June 5, at the Army Aviation Support Facility in Pendleton. The unit will leave for Ft. Hood, Texas on June 8.
