Gabriel L. Cox has been active outside the classroom holding leadership positions in Key Club, Drama Club, and a member of National Honor Society. Gabby has gone beyond the basic expectations of club service and has volunteered for many additional activities, such as serving at community breakfasts, and organizing children's games and the Fun Run at the annual 4th of July Celebration.

Gabriel will enroll at the University of Idaho as a math major.

Evelyn Garcia has been described by many as a "Natural Leader." Willing to be involved, she has been a Cinco de Mayo folkloric dancer for many years, sang in the choir of both her church and Riverside High School, a RHS cheerleader, Key Club member and volunteered at the monthly community breakfasts, and at "No Room At The Inn." Three sessions of swim lessons will be held this year. The first will be June 28 through July 8. The second will be July 19-29. The last session will be August 9-19. The cost for swim lessons is \$35 per session or \$30 if you have a swim pass.

Individual passes are \$75 and family passes are \$150. Daily rates are \$2 for 0-4 years and senior citizens, \$3 for 5-17 years, and \$4 for adults (18+).
