Ione Cardinal Booster Club memberships available

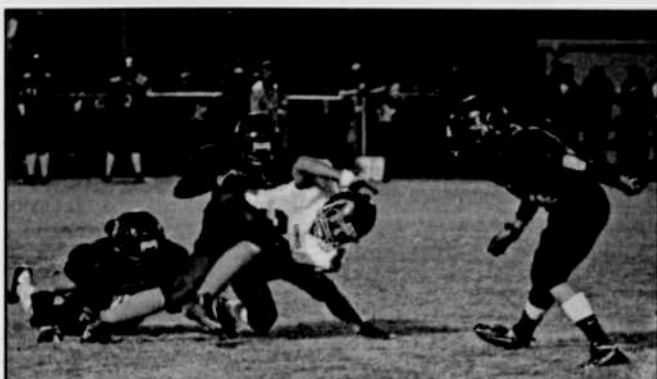
Ione Cardinal Booster Club memberships are available to businesses and families.
