 grade, 27 in fifth grade and 25 in sixth grade. Heppner Junior/Senior High School currently has 28 students in seventh grade, 29 in eighth, 27 in ninth, 43 in 10<sup>th</sup>, 52 in 11<sup>th</sup> and 33 in 12<sup>th</sup>.

A.C. Houghton Elementary, Irrigon, kindergarten through grade three, had 257; Irrigon Elementary, grades four-six-222; Riverside High School, Boardman, grades seven-12-326; Sam Boardman Elementary, Boardman, kindergarten through grade three-303; Windy River Elementary, Boardman, grades four-six-221; Morrow Education Center-Morrow County School District students-46; MEC-Umatilla School District school district stu-

dents-18; total-2195.  
 Also at the meeting, the board voted to abolish the district's local school committees. The board concluded that the school committee system is not working. Generally no one runs for the positions and consequently the elections are an unnecessary expense for the district. Administration also says that the site councils at each school provide much of the same review and advice as any local school committee.

In other business, the board:

-approved the first reading of a policy revision, adding the statement that retaliation is prohibited against anyone who files a claim of discrimination, participates in a proceeding

or otherwise opposes discrimination under federal or state laws.

-approved the first reading of a policy revision, adding the statement that veteran's status and genetic information will be protected in the district's equal opportunity statement.

-accepted the first reading of policy revisions concerning the hiring of educational assistants, which added the statement that educational assistants must have a high school diploma or the equivalent, be at least 18 years or older, have standards of more character as required of teachers, ed assistants providing translation services must have knowledge of and the ability to provide accurate translations from a language other than English

into English and vice versa; added a "para-professional certificate program" to the accepted "formal state or local academic assessment"; added "specialist or supervisor" in addition to the classroom teacher that the ed assistant is to assist; added the following tasks that the assistant may be required to do: clerical support, student control, personal care, translation or parent/family involvement activities and media center or computer laboratory support.

-approved the first reading of policy on personal communication devices and social media for staff as follows: staff possession or use of personal communications on district property, in district facilities and while the staff is on

duty at district-sponsored activities will be permitted with certain limitations. Staff will be subject to disciplinary action, including dismissal, to use the PCD for illegal purposes, including obscene or pornographic material and will be reported to law enforcement and other appropriate agencies. Burrows said that use of the devices by staff on the school grounds will be permitted, but only during staff off-time, such as lunch periods, breaks and after school.

-approved a revision of the district's policy on personal communication devices and social media to include "other digital audio devices (iPods)" and banning students from accessing "social media sites using district equip-

ment on district property or at district-sponsored activities unless the posting is approved by a district representative. The district will not be liable for information/comments posted by students on social media Web sites," "such as, but not limited to Facebook, MySpace and Twitter."

-approved the following employment action: resignations/retirements-Colleen Cunningham, ACH English language learner teacher, who requested to finish the year in a half-time position under a job-share scenario; Martie McQuain, IJSHS head girls' basketball coach; employment-Melissa Dunn, SBE temporary assistant cook, replacing Bonnie Matlack; Minerva DeLoera, RHS ELL ed assistant (rehired); Bart Prouty, ACH three-fourths time assistant custodian; promotion-Stormy Botefuhr, from IJH assistant volleyball coach to head volleyball coach; extra duty contracts-Stormy Botefuhr, Joy Hearn, IJH assistant volleyball coach, IJSHS assistant girls' basketball coach (did not resign this position when she resigned regular employment as an ed assistant); Rick Gerard, IJH assistant football coach.

-approved the appointment of Nicole Mahoney as a budget committee member at the recommendation of board member Thad Killingbeck. Mahoney agreed to serve another term.

-approved a request from Ricky Fay, Irrigon Junior/Senior High School teacher, for an educational student trip to the East Coast.

-heard from Burrows about a possible drastic and immediate raising of state standards required of students which could adversely affect Morrow County Schools. "I'm not against higher standards," said Burrows. He added, however, that teachers should have received advance notice of the changes in time to prepare and teach toward those standards.

-learned from Burrows that the state school funding estimate is holding at 5.736 billion, a nine percent decrease from spring estimates.

-heard the following announcements: Thursday, October 28-end of the first nine-weeks; Monday, November 8-next board meeting, 7 p.m., Morrow Education Center, Irrigon; Thursday, November 11-Veteran's Day holiday; Thursday-Friday, November 11-14, Oregon School Board Association fall convention, Portland.
