Oregon East Symphony features Young Artists and Dvorak's New World Symphony

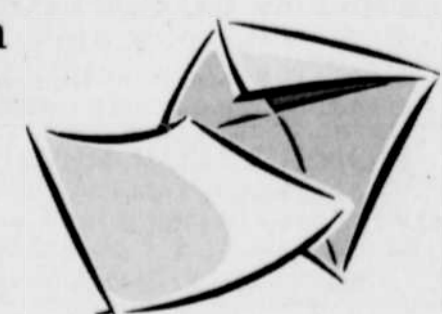

Guest conductor, Dr. Beau Benson will take listeners to a new world of sound with Dvorak's Symphony #9. The OES loves to perform newly composed music, especially when it comes from a composer of Chris Thomas's caliber. This original movie medley will have you dancing in your seats and begging for more. In keeping with OES tradition, this concert highlights the musical talents of exemplary young musicians, accompanied by the orchestra.
