The Morrow County District Attorney's Office has released the following report:

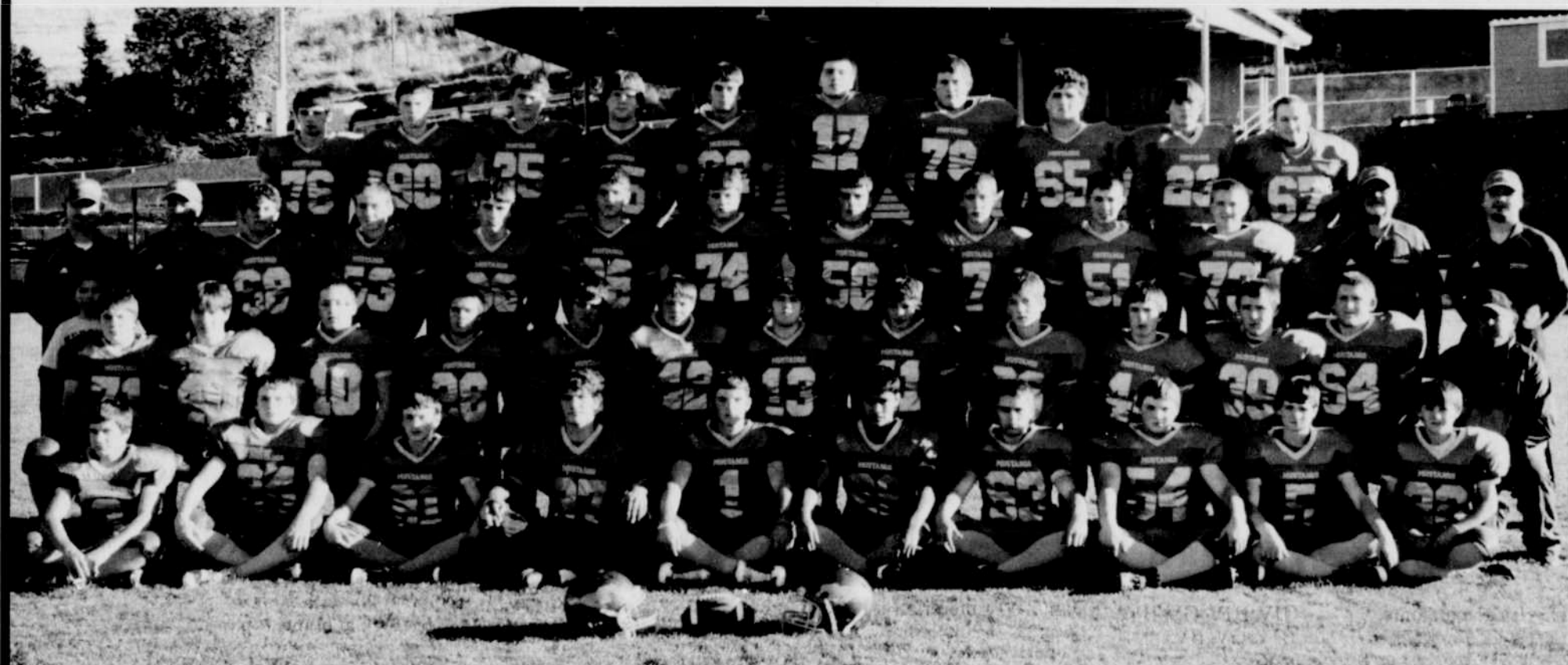
Sweet Productions to host gingerbread house workshop
