## Ione High School ASB organizes canned food drive

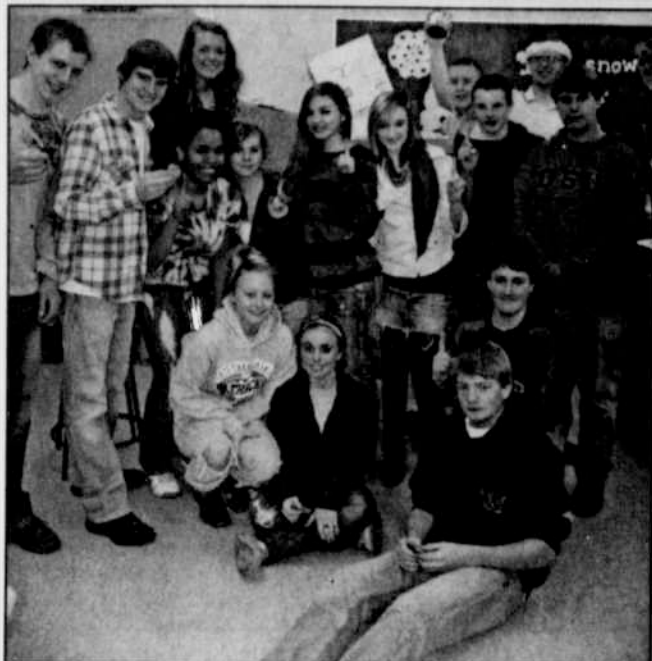
