The Morrow County District Attorney's Office has released the following report:

**NOAA issues monthly climate summary for Heppner**

According to preliminary data received by NOAA's National Weather Service in Pendleton, temperatures at Heppner averaged slightly colder than normal during the month of March.

The average temperature was 43.5 degrees which was 0.4 degrees below normal. High Temperatures averaged 53.1 degrees, which was 1.2 degrees below normal. The highest was 64 degrees on the 10<sup>th</sup>. Low temperatures averaged 33.9 degrees, which was 0.3 degrees above normal. The lowest was 27 degrees, on the 17<sup>th</sup>.

There were 13 days with the low temperature below 32 degrees.

Precipitation totaled 1.82 inches during March, which was 0.22 inches above normal. Measurable precipitation -at least .01 inch- was received on 21 days with the heaviest, 0.25 inches reported on the 1<sup>st</sup>.

Precipitation this year has reached 3.81 inches, which is 0.48 inches below normal. Since October, the water year precipitation at Heppner has been 9.73 inches, which is 1.65 inches above normal.

The outlook for April from NOAA's Climate Prediction Center calls for below normal temperatures and above normal precipitation. Normal highs for Heppner rise from 59.4 degrees at the start of April to 62.9 degrees at the end of April. Normal lows rise from 36.1 degrees to 38.3 degrees. The 30 year normal precipitation is 1.40 inches.

The National Weather Service is an office of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, an agency of the U.S. Commerce Department.
