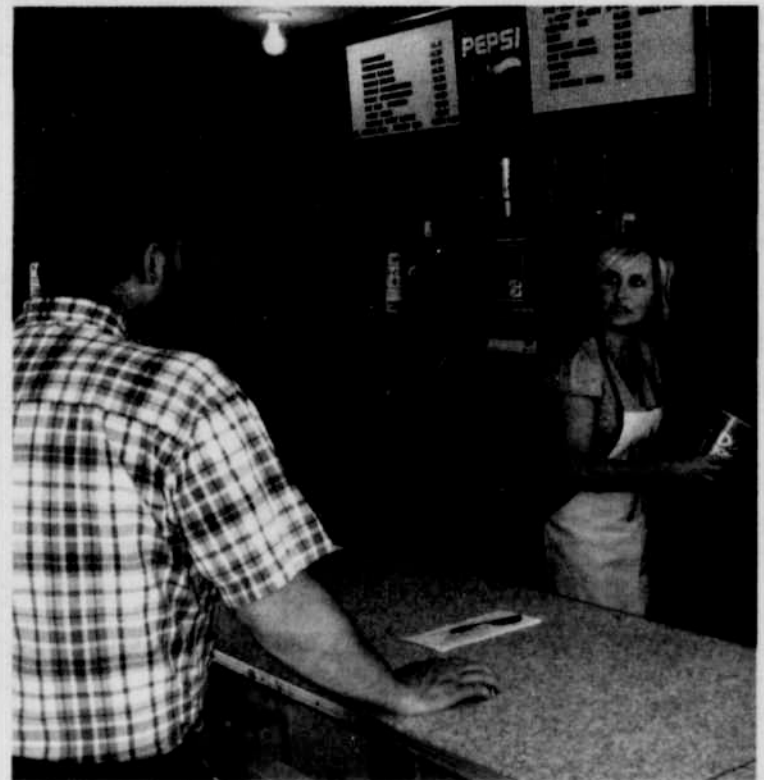
4-H Snack Shack feeds fair-goers, also major source of income for 4-H Leaders Council
