OTLD expands 24/7 access at branch libraries

The Oregon Trail Library District (OTLD) has joined with other libraries across eastern Oregon to expand its remote services, now adding World Book Encyclopedia to its roster of on line services that include Library2Go and Tutor.com.

OTLD now offers the full 2012 encyclopedia and its content to area residents, along with down-loadable audio books, e-books and videos and educational resources that have already been available to residents from any internet connection 24 hours a day.

World Book Encyclopedia, Library2Go and Tutor.com are brought to Boardman and Heppner branch libraries and the interim library services station at Irrigon through funding provided by Libraries of Eastern Oregon (LEO), Wildhorse Foundation, and the library district. LEO was able to obtain significant discounts through a group-buy to 53 public libraries in 16 counties.

Each service can be accessed by going to the designated website and entering one's library card number provided by the district.

"Having these services is the most significant change to public libraries in eastern Oregon in decades," said

Ken Reading, LEO board chair and director of the Umatilla County library system. "We're actually rolling out the libraries to the front steps of every home in the region."

World Book Encyclopedia Public Libraries Edition On Line features the entire award-winning 2012 adult and student encyclopedia editions in English and Spanish with added offerings such as music, videos, children's activities, interactive games, and much more, including current content from the major newspapers from every country in the world and data recently made available from the 2010 U.S. Census.

A direct website to reach World Book On Line has been created for OTLD. The access point is linked from the library website and can be accessed from any location 24/7 with a valid library card.

"We are absolutely elated to be able to bring this service throughout all 16 LEO counties," said Derek Collett, Oregon's World Book representative.

"It's now as if we're placing the World Book Encyclopedia and all of its interactive content in every single household in eastern Oregon that has internet," Collett said.

Library2Go is an on-line service from the Oregon Digital Library Consortium. The service offers 15,675 down-loadable audiobooks, 1300 videos and 12, 295 e-books - current editions and classics - that can be immediately downloaded to a computer or mobile device such as an iPod, MP3 player or other device.

Audiobooks are digital books that one listens to, like music on a CD, and Library2Go videos are recent documentaries and other movies. E-books are digital books that can be read from a computer or device such as Nook. Six Library2Go items can be checked out at a time from any personal computer with an internet connection for up to two or three weeks, depending on item. The down-loadable files expire and are unplayable or unreadable after that time, although materials can be checked out again.

Tutor.com brings live tutors on line from 2-10 p.m. seven days per week over the next year for students and persons of all ages.

Qualified tutors provide assistance to students in all areas of mathematics, sciences, social studies and English from kindergarten through college, and to adults through an Adult

Education Center with resume-building, research, study help for GED or citizenship tests, and much more. The bilingual service package also includes a career center and writing center for adults.

The service can be accessed by going to www.tutor.com/leo and entering one's library card number. "We're hoping residents will try these resources, find how easy they are to use, and use them often," said Marsha Richmond, OTLD director.

OTLD is part of the regional SAGE catalog system, which provides 24/7 internet access to 1.3 million library items - the entire contents of more than 70 other public and academic libraries in eastern Oregon.

Materials can be ordered from any library in eastern Oregon by using an OTLD library card, and then delivered by courier within a few days to the hometown library at no cost to borrowers. Materials can be returned to any library in the region.
