

Oregon Parks and Recreation Department plans hearing on proposed Heppner bikeway

The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) is conducting hearings on several proposed bikeways, including the proposed Blue Mountain Century scenic bikeway route which passes through Heppner and Ukiah, on Wednesday, September 14, from 5-6 p.m. at the Heppner City Hall, 111 North Main St.

Besides The Blue Mountain Century bikeway, others include the Old West Bikeway, passing through John Day and Monument, The McKenzie Pass, The Metolius Loops and The Sisters to Smith Rock State Park.

Other public hearings on proposed routes for scenic bikeways in towns along each route include one for the proposed McKenzie Pass, Sisters to Smith Rock and

Metolius Loops bikeways, is scheduled for Monday, September 12, from 5-6 p.m. in Sisters at the Sisters Chamber of Commerce on 291 E. Main Ave.

The final hearing, for the proposed Old West Bikeway hearing is Thursday, September 15, from 5 - 6 p.m. in the Eastern Oregon Realty Office, 160 E. Main Street in John Day.

Alex Phillips, Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) Bicycle and Water Recreation coordinator, will accept written public comment on the recommended bikeways no later than 5 p.m. the day preceding each hearing.
