

Change for charity at Community Bank

The Heppner Community Bank will again be participating in the bank's annual Change for Charity Drive. The fundraising drive, which will take place at each Community Bank branch, will take place from November 1 through December 15.

The program is an effort to collect funds in the community, to be used in the community. Community Bank matches 50 cents on every dollar, up to \$5,000. Each branch manager has selected a charity that will directly benefit the citizens in the area. The Heppner branch is collecting funds for the Heppner Neighborhood Center.

In addition to the local aspect, the two bank regions—east and west—are in competition to see who raises the most money for their charities. Community Bank will donate an extra \$1,000 to the charities in the region where the most donations are collected. Heppner is in the western region, along with branches in Hermiston, Pendleton, Milton-Freewater, Walla

and Clarkston. The total funds collected will be calculated after December 15, when the winning region will be determined.

The 2010 Community Bank Change for Charity Drive collected and matched a total of more than \$11,800 for charities. The east region was the competition winner last year, and earned the charities in Wallowa, Union, and Baker County the extra \$1,000 donated by the bank. More than \$7,600 was given to the charities in those counties. The western region collected enough—after the bank match—to donate about \$4,200 to the charities in Umatilla, Morrow, Walla Walla and Asotin counties. They hope to beat out eastern region branches for the extra matching money this year.

All branches will have donation jars available November 1 through December 15. Coins and bills are accepted. Those with questions about the Change for Charity Drive can contact their local branch manager.

Cash prizes reward healthier life

The Community Health Improvement Partnership (CHIP) of Morrow County will be sponsoring the "Biggest Winner," a 12-week weight-loss competition and healthy lifestyle program. It will begin January 9, 2012 and run until April 2, 2012.

The contest will be held in Boardman, Irrigon, Lone and Heppner. The top three individuals in each community who achieve the greatest percentage of body weight lost will each receive awards...\$500 for first place, \$300 for second place and \$100 for third.

Weekly sessions will teach participants how to make life-long health behavior changes for main-

taining a healthy weight, preventing disease, incorporating physical activity in their lives, managing stress and reducing tobacco use. Everyone is encouraged to sign up for the competition and win weight-loss prizes. Further details will be coming soon.

The CHIP is an alliance of local health-care organizations working with the community to develop strategies to improve the health of Morrow County. The partnership received grant support from the Oregon Office of Rural Health, and Regence and PacificSource Foundations, to assess local health needs and "Improve Health from Rivers to Rolling Hills."

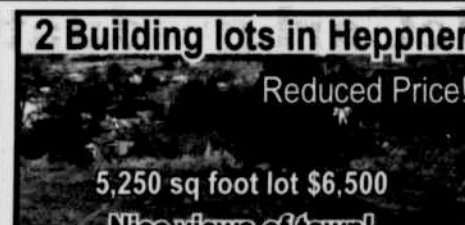

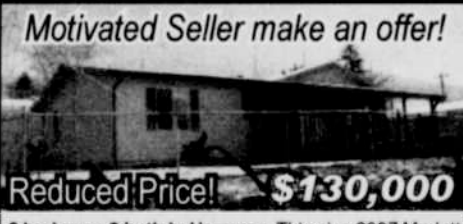

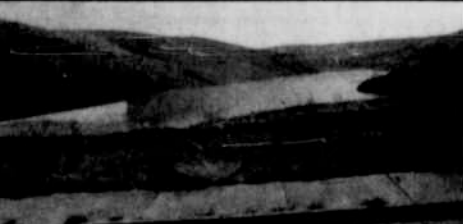
