Bureau of Reclamation Water Service Contracting; Willow Creek Project, Oregon
Under the authority of §9(e) of the Act of August 4, 1939 (53 Stat. 1187), §8 of the Act of December 22, 1944 (58 Stat. 887, 891),

and the Flood Control Act of 1962 (76 Stat. 1173), the United States Bureau of Reclamation proposes to enter into negotiations for a short-term, 2-year contract with the Willow Creek District Improvement Company that would allow for the use of up to 2,073.6 acre-feet of storage water for irrigation use on 2,538.14 acres of land during the 2012 and 2013 irrigation seasons.

The proposed short-term contract has been evaluated under the National Environmental Policy Act, the Endangered Species Act and other compliance requirements.

The Morrow County District Attorney's office has released the following report:

- Alejandro Javier Nunez, 32, was convicted of criminal mischief in the second degree and interference with making a report, both Class A misdemeanors, and harassment, a Class B misdemeanor. Sentence of 180 days jail time for each

count was replaced with 36 months bench probation per count, conditional on completion of probation requirements. Probation includes 80 hours community service, approved anger management classes and no contact with a specified subject except for approved parenting time purposes. Total fines, fees and assessments were \$3,654.

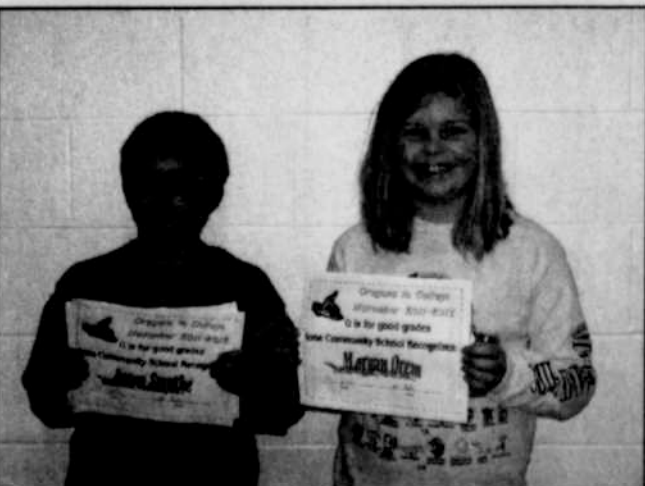
Parks board to meet
