

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reports handling the following business:

August 11: -MCSO arrested Nathan Edward Warren Talbert, 36, for driving while suspended-misdemeanor.

-MCSO arrested Shawn Michael Chandler, 33, on an Irrigon Justice Court warrant for failure to appear/driving while suspended.

-A female caller reporter that another female walked by her residence and challenged her to a fight. The caller declined.

-MCSO received a report that a red Honda car with Washington plates came off the freeway onto Hwy 730 at a high rate of speed and failed to stop

at the stop sign. Caller advised the vehicle almost crashed into him. Vehicle then turned onto Bombing Range and then onto Wilson Lane. The vehicle failed to maintain a single lane of travel. BPD contacted and warned the driver for careless driving. Caller did not want to sign a citation.

August 13: -MCSO received a report from a man who said there was yelling at a nearby house; the male was telling the female to get out, and the caller did not know if it was physical or if they were intoxicated. Deputy made contact; subjects were playing a game of poker and were highly intoxicated.
