On or about April 12, 2012 Morrow County will submit a Request for Release of Funds (RROF) to the Oregon Business Development Department (OBDD) for the release of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended, for its housing rehabilitation program. The purpose of the County's housing rehabilitation program is to use to perform repair and rehabilitation of existing single-family, owner-occupied units located in Morrow County. Annually, the program rehabilitates over 10 low-to-moderate-income homes with approximately \$200,000 of CDBG funds. Specific locations of individual units to be rehabilitated cannot be determined prior to the completion of the Area-Wide Environmental Review and the RROF.
