

Five area students "State Fair" at Heppner High School earn EOU honors

Five Morrow County students were among the 600 students named to the Eastern Oregon University dean's list for the 2012 winter term.

Area students who received the honor were Sheryl Peck and Eric Jepsen of Heppner, Alan Rietmann of Ione, Kelli Jones of Boardman and Klarissa Hendrix of Irrigon.

To qualify, students must achieve and maintain a grade point average of 3.5 or higher while completing a minimum of 12 hours of graded coursework for the duration of the term.

The Heppner High School drama department will present Rodgers and Hammerstein's musical "State Fair" on May 3, 4 and 5 at 7 p.m. and May 7 at 1 p.m. and 7 p.m. Tickets are \$5 for adults and \$3 students.

"State Fair," the musical, is based on the 1946 film by the same name starring Jeanne Crain and Vivian Blaine. It is the story of the Frakes—an Iowa farm family who travels to the state fair. The parents, Abel and Melissa, dream of blue ribbons for their prize boar, "Blue Boy," as well as for Grandma's famous mincemeat. Their children, Wayne and Margy, venture out onto the midway and have adventures of their own.

More than 25 Heppner youth have been rehearsing State Fair since mid-March. The cast includes students from grades four through 12.

Senior Jeff McConnell will play the part of Abel Frake; Junior Tessa Gould will play his wife, Melissa. Senior Shane Smith stars as 21-year-old Wayne Frake, and Sophomore Samm Lemmon as his sister, Margy. Sophomores Treton Maben and Micha Hintz are featured as the newspaperman, Pat Gilbert, and the singer, Emily Arden, respectively.

Musical numbers include Margy's lament, "It Might As Well Be Spring," and Abel's ode to Blue Boy, "More Than Just a Friend." Duets "Isn't It

Kinda Fun?" and "So Far" divulge the excitement of young love, while "When I Go out Walking with My Baby" illustrates the affection of a happy marriage.

Concessions will be provided by Heppner High School's Art & Culture Club. On Saturday, the Art & Culture Club will host a special event prior to the show. This Art & Culture Fair will include

food, games, face painting and crafts, and will be held in the cafeteria from 5-7 p.m. Admission to the Art & Culture Fair is \$5, or \$3 with a ticket to the show.
