Once again, the fair superintendents will be anxiously awaiting exhibitors on Monday afternoon, **August 13, from 1-8 p.m. to receive entries in the fair.**

Open Class fruits, vegetables and flowers will be accepted on Monday from 4-8 p.m. and Tuesday morning from 8-10 a.m.

This year, all Open Class

exhibits will be released on Sunday morning, August 19, from 9-11 a.m., at the same time 4-H exhibits are released.

If, for some reason, you can't make it on Sunday morning, the Fair Office will be open Monday through Friday the week following fair from 8 a.m. till noon and again from 1-5 p.m. for pick-up of items. After 30 days, those exhibits that are left will become the property of the Morrow County Fair and may be discarded.
