Youth hunters 17 and under can sign up for free upland bird hunts taking

place at 12 locations across the state in September.

To register, sign up on-

line, at a license sales agent, or at an Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) office that sells licenses. The hunts are free, though youth hunters need a valid hunting license (\$14.50) and upland game bird validation (\$8.50) to hunt. Only youth already certified in hunter education are eligible to participate.

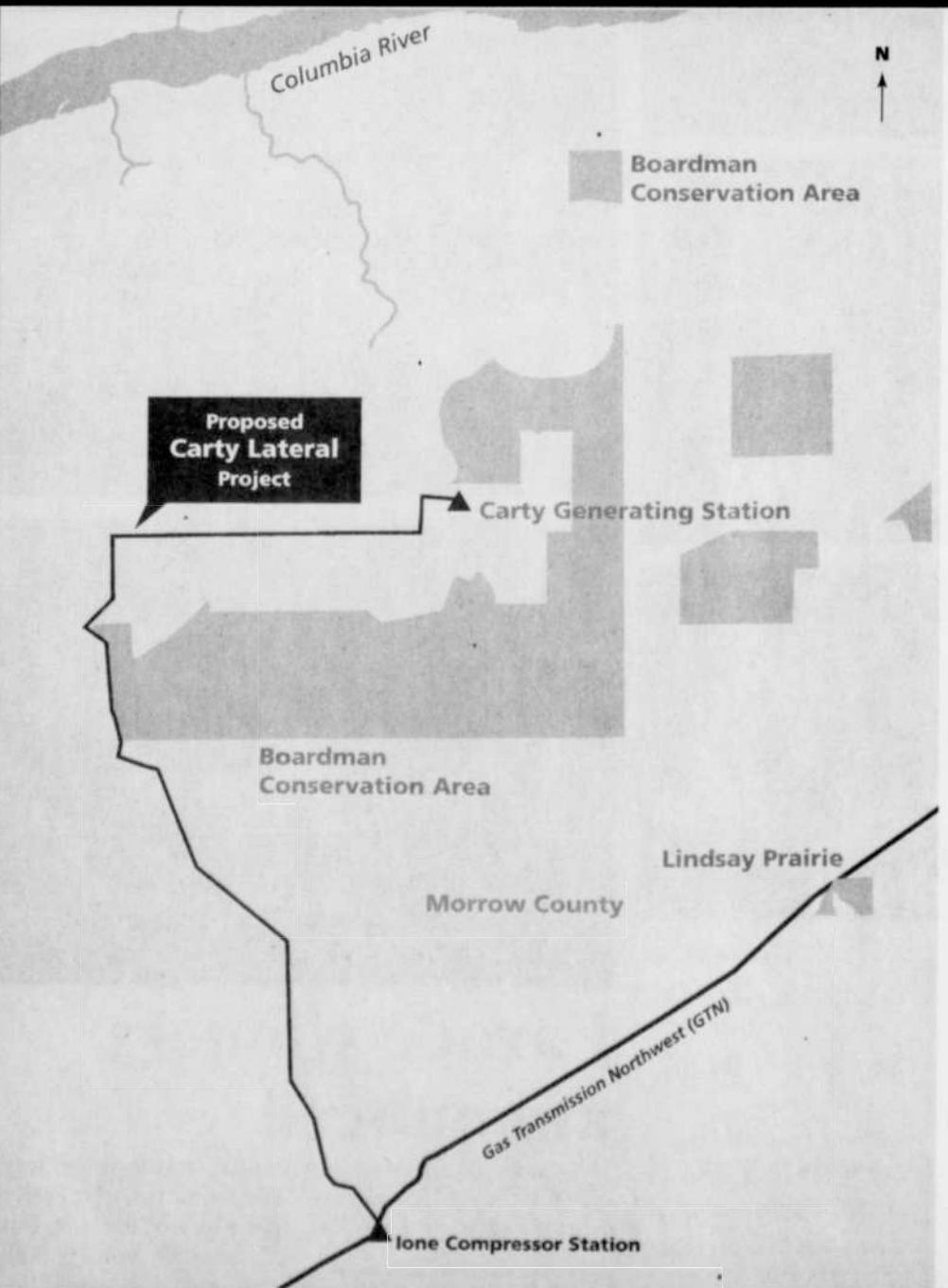

Gas Transmission Northwest LLC Files Application for Carty Lateral Project



On July 31, 2012, Gas Transmission Northwest LLC (GTN) filed an application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) requesting authorization to construct a natural gas transmission pipeline in Morrow County, Oregon. This project, called the Carty Lateral Project, is subject to the jurisdiction of FERC under the Natural Gas Act. On August 7, 2012, FERC assigned Docket No. CP12-494-000 to this application.

Specifically, GTN proposes to install:

- Approximately 24.3 miles of 20-inch-diameter natural gas pipeline extending north from GTN's existing Compressor Station 9 near Ione, Oregon, and terminating at a connection with the proposed Carty Generating Station to be owned and operated by Portland General Electric Company (PGE).
- Various aboveground facilities associated with pipeline operation, safety and natural gas measurement.

The proposed project has a design capacity of approximately 175,000 dekatherms per day. Pending receipt of regulatory authorizations, pipeline construction and completion is scheduled to take place in 2014.

The Carty Lateral Project would benefit PGE customers with added reliability provided by additional natural gas-fired generating capacity. The project will be designed and constructed to meet or exceed the safety standards established for natural gas transmission pipelines by the U.S. Department of Transportation.

The FERC's Notice of Application (NOA) and pamphlet for landowners entitled, "An Interstate Pipeline On My Land? What Do I Need to Know?" are available at the FERC website at www.ferc.gov. FERC's Office of External Affairs may be reached by telephone at 202-502-8004 or toll-free at 800-208-3372.
