Four to five years old— First, Hallee Hisler; second, Sarina McDowell; and third, Sierra Greenup.

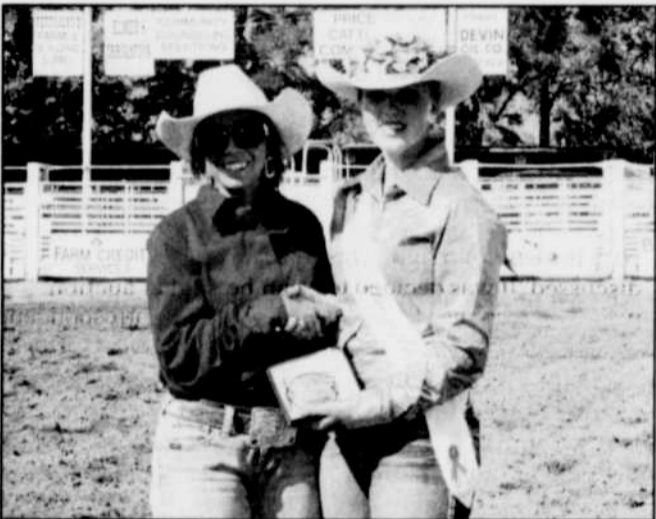
Six to seven years old—First, Morgan Alldritt; second, Ty Boor; and third, Faith Futter.
