Board member requirements include attending monthly meetings, working during fair time and going to convention, if possible, in addition to other times of the year when members may be asked to volunteer or help out.

Heppner schools offer new website

To find the website, go to the HES website at www.hes.morrow.k12.or.us; on the left-hand side, click on HES/HJSHS EVENTS and it will take you to the rSchoolWebsite. Parents and community members can view by day or week, or find the "advanced view" and select the types of events they would like to look at. Viewers will also have the option to print pages.

The other great feature is the "Notify Me" option for anyone who would like to receive updates as things change or are cancelled. On the website, click on "Notify Me!" on the right side

of the page near the calendar. Fill out the information for email or text messages and select the events about which you would like to be informed. The first page will ask about the sports activities; click "continue" to find school events. It is quick and easy, and a great way to know about last minute changes.
