Request to Amend Site Certificate**

Summary
Date this Notice was Issued: Oct. 3, 2012

Proposal: Remove three conditions from the site certificate relating to air quality issues that are under the jurisdiction of the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality and addressed in the Oregon Title V Operation Permit for the Coyote Springs plant.

Location: (200 Ullman Blvd., Boardman) the facility consists of approximately 20 acres within the Port of Morrow Industrial Park.

Amendment Comment Deadline:
Nov. 5, 2012 (5 p.m.)

Introduction

The Oregon Department of Energy, which serves as staff to the Energy Facility Siting Council; has received a request to amend the site certificate from Portland General Electric. The request is to remove three conditions of approval from the site certificate relating to air quality issues that are under the jurisdiction of the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality and addressed in the Oregon Title V Operation Permit for the Coyote Springs plant.

According to Oregon law (ORS 469.405), the Energy Facility Siting Council can approve an amendment to a site certificate.

Description of Proposed Amendment

The proposed amendment will remove three conditions in Section XI of the site certificate, which sets forth "Conditions Issued Pursuant to Applicant Representations." Conditions XI(3), XI(4) and XI(7). These conditions all relate to air quality emissions and/or air pollution controls, specifically to emissions of and controls for NOx - oxides of nitrogen - a criteria air pollutant regulated under the Clean Air Act:

XI(3) NOx emissions shall be controlled to 25 parts per million (ppm) on natural gas.

XI(4) Each heat recovery steam generator shall be provided with an ammonia injection system and selective catalytic reduction system to further reduce the NOx emissions at the stack outlet.

XI(7) The low NOx burners on the auxiliary boiler shall control emissions to a maximum of 40 ppm at the stack outlet.

These criteria would instead be under the jurisdiction of the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality and currently addressed in the Oregon Title V Operation Permit for the Coyote Springs plant.

Location of Proposed Project

The project consists of approximately 20 acres within the Port of Morrow Industrial Park. The Port of Morrow Industrial Park is in the city of Boardman and along the Columbia River. The plant site is located approximately 1,500 feet due south of the Columbia River and is immediately south of the bank and berm created by the Union Pacific Railroad's east-west mainline.

Council's Review Process

After reviewing the proposed amendment and any comments received, ODOE will prepare a Proposed Order that will recommend to the Energy Facility Siting Council (EFSC) the approval, modification, or denial of the amendment request. Upon the release of the Proposed Order, ODOE will issue a public notice that will announce a 30-day period for comments or requests for a contested case hearing. The notice will explain the right to request a contested case hearing on the Proposed Order.

Comment Period

Public comments on the amendment request are encouraged to help the applicant identify issues and concerns early in the process. Comments, which are due by Nov. 5, 2012 at 5 p.m., must be submitted in writing by mail, e-mail, hand-delivery or fax. Please address to: Mo Walker, Energy Analyst
