He shared that they had prepared for this sacrament for two years by a deeper study of the Catholic faith, had performed many hours of charitable service, and had attended a spiritual retreat. Each student had also chosen for themselves a special patron saint.

An anonymous source pointed out that Father Condon and Joe Lindsay had composed "...a beautiful and meaningful confirmation song that is sure to gain fame if the Vatican gets hold of it."
