Morrow County Public Works is accepting bids for crane lift removal of a portion of the existing clock tower and bell from the Morrow County Courthouse, located 100 S. Court Street in Heppner, OR. It is anticipated that two separate lift dates, one for the removal of the existing structure and bell and one for the placement of the reconstructed structure and bell, will be required. Each date will require 2 or more lifts as determined by the contractor. The existing clock tower structure to be removed is estimated at 7,200 lbs. The bell is estimated to weigh 3,050 lbs. The existing tower structure and bell will be prepared for removal by others prior to the arrival of the Crane contractor. The Contractor shall lift the structure and bell

and lower it to a location directly adjacent to the Courthouse.

On the second lift date, the contractor shall crane lift the re-constructed tower structure and bell back into position on the Courthouse building.
