## You can do it!

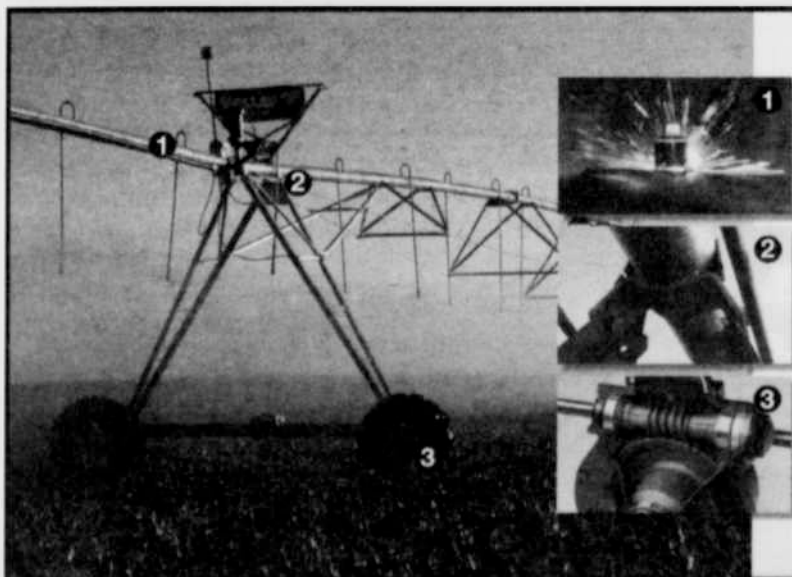
Have you attended previous county fairs and, after looking at the exhibits, thought, "I can do that"?
