

## Sheriff's Report

Municipal Court on July 16. Marijuana and Maintaining a Place Where Drugs are Kept or Sold. He was lodged at Umatilla County Jail. MCSO also arrested Cole Noah Crosswaite, 24, on probable cause charges of Possession of a Controlled Substance-Marijuana, Distribution of a Controlled Substance-Marijuana; Manufacture of a Controlled Substance-Marijuana, Frequenting a Place Where Drugs are Kept or Sold and Unlawful Possession of Silencers. He was lodged at UCJ. A third subject was cited and released on probable cause charges of Frequenting a Place Where Drugs are Kept or Sold.

-MCSO received report from a woman who said she had a court order for subjects to be out of a residence she owns by noon, but they were not yet out by 12:17 p.m. and said they would not be out that day. The caller called back to cancel the deputy because the subjects were moving and should be out in an hour.
