

Sheriff's Report

July 21: Morrow County Sheriff's Office received report of a non-injury hit and run on Hwy. 730 in Irrigon. The caller was not there when the hit and run occurred.

-MCSO received report from a subject who was concerned about leaving his car at Bake's in Irrigon following the hit and run that had just occurred.

-MCSO received report of a male subject urinating in Bake's parking lot. The subject was given a warning for public urination.

-MCSO received report from a woman in Boardman who said she was in a vehicle with a subject threatening suicide.

-MCSO received report that Umatilla Police Department arrested James Daniel Riley, 27, on a Morrow County warrant for Failure to Appear/Driving While Suspended misdemeanor. He was lodged at Umatilla County Jail with \$6,000 bail.

-MCSO cited Richard Fislser for two counts of Driving While Suspended-violation, resulting from a hit and run.

-MCSO received report of a drive off for \$5 at the Heppner gas station. The subject came back and paid.

-MCSO received report of someone trying to break into a car in Irrigon.

-MCSO received report of someone ranting and keeping others in the Baltimore Apartments up during the previous night and was doing it again the next night.

-MCSO received report of a semi truck with a fire behind the cab in Boardman. The driver was trying to put it out with a fire extinguisher. Boardman Fire Department, Boardman Ambulance, MCSO and Oregon Department of Transportation responded.

-MCSO received report of a female at a Heppner store attempting to steal a pack of cigarettes, placing them down her pants.
