

## Sheriff's Report

**September 21 (cont.):** -MCSO received request for assistance from an Irrigon woman whose husband had fallen off the bed. He did not need medical assistance, just lift assist. Irrigon Fire Department and Irrigon Ambulance responded.

## DA's Report

Morrow County District Attorney Justin Nelson has released the following report:

-Dakota Wayne Kamna, 21, was convicted of three counts of Assault IV, a Class A misdemeanor. Of the sentence of 180 days jail time for each count, 177 days jail time was suspended and the defendant sentenced to 24 months bench probation for each count. Conditions of

probation included 60 hours of community service per count, alcohol evaluation and/or treatment, no offensive physical contact with any of the victims, and a written apology to each victim. Jail time of three days per count was included as a condition of probation, with credit for time served, time to run consecutive. Total fines, fees and assessments were \$400.
