Technicians and emergency room staff, the HoverMatt reduces the lifting and straining," Rhea concluded.

Pioneer Memorial Hospital currently keeps similar, though larger, mats on two of the gurneys in the ER for intra-hospital transfers. Funds from the remembrance walk/run would allow the hospital to have a smaller HoverMatt in each Heppner-based ambulance.

Miller said similar mats are used in many area ambulances, including Hermiston. In fact, she said EMT trainee Tina Davidson first brought the idea to her attention after seeing them in action on other ambulances she has ridden along on in her training.

As for why the hospital chose the HoverMatt out of all possible needs, Miller said price, as well as need, was a factor.

"We have to give them (Friends Helping Friends) an obtainable goal. The HoverMatt is \$4,000 for a couple of them. There are other things we can use, but they're tens of thousands of dollars," she said.
