

Ione pool opens Friday

The Ione Community Pool will open for the season this Friday with a celebration from 1-4 p.m.

The community is invited to attend the event, which includes not only free pool admission but also free hotdogs and popcorn.

The school is also planning free swimming lessons for all elementary students starting Monday and going through the end of the school year.

An informational meeting led by Keri Heideman will take place June 11 at 3:45 p.m. in the school library; Heideman will be sharing information about swimming lessons and the AAU swim team.

Five levels of swimming lessons in two separate sessions will be offered mornings, Monday through Friday. Swimming lessons are \$30 per two-week session.

AAU swim team practice will also be held in the mornings.

Beginning Friday, June 13, the pool will hold open swim 1-4 p.m. daily, adult swim 4-5 p.m. daily, and open swim 5-8 p.m. daily. Cost is \$2 per session or \$100 for a family season
