STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN ACTIVITIES AND SOURCES OF FINANCING**

The significant changes in the district for the current year is the anticipated increase in funding of nearly \$872,000, which is nearly all from local revenue and the fact we receive 51% of our total State School Fund grant (49% was received last year). The additional revenue will be offset by an increase in payroll costs which includes the 3% COLA and an increase in transfers to capital outlay to fund future projects for the district. These projects include HVAC controls, ventilators, and buildings.
