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**Sheriff's Report**

**March 15 (cont.):**

-MCSO, Boardman Police Department received report from a woman in Irrigon that another woman threatened to kill her and had a knife. MCSO responded.

-MCSO received report from a Heppner man that an intoxicated female got into an altercation with his son. 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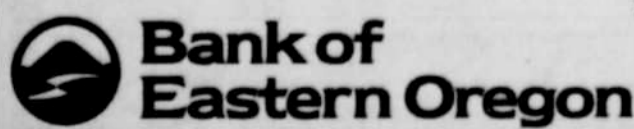
