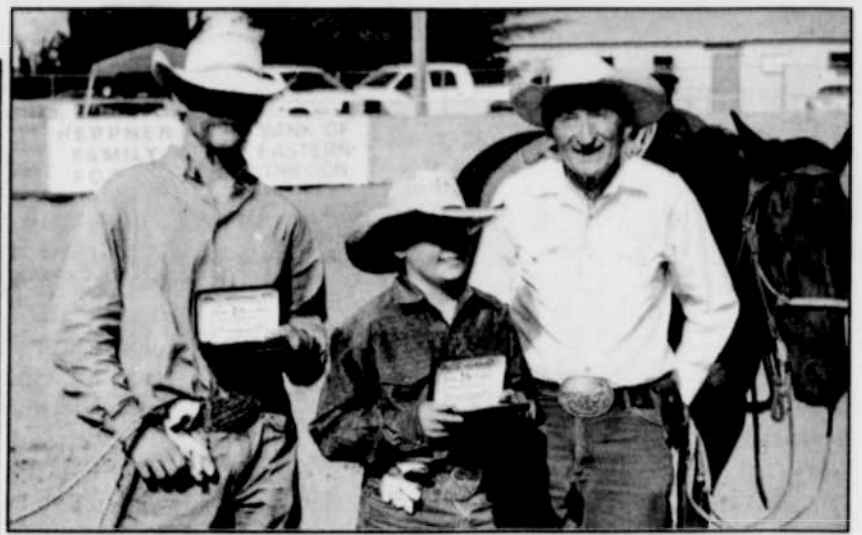

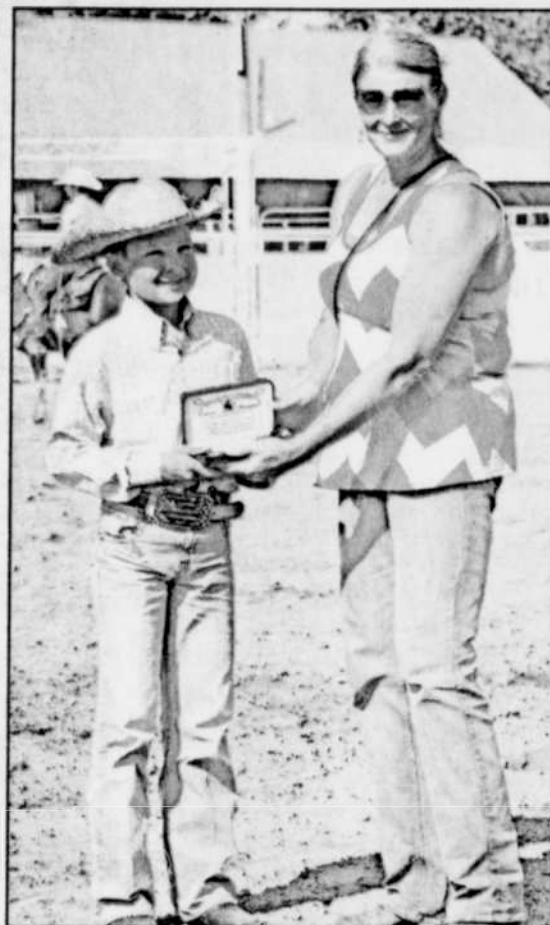
All Around champions Garrett Robinson and Tate Bailey



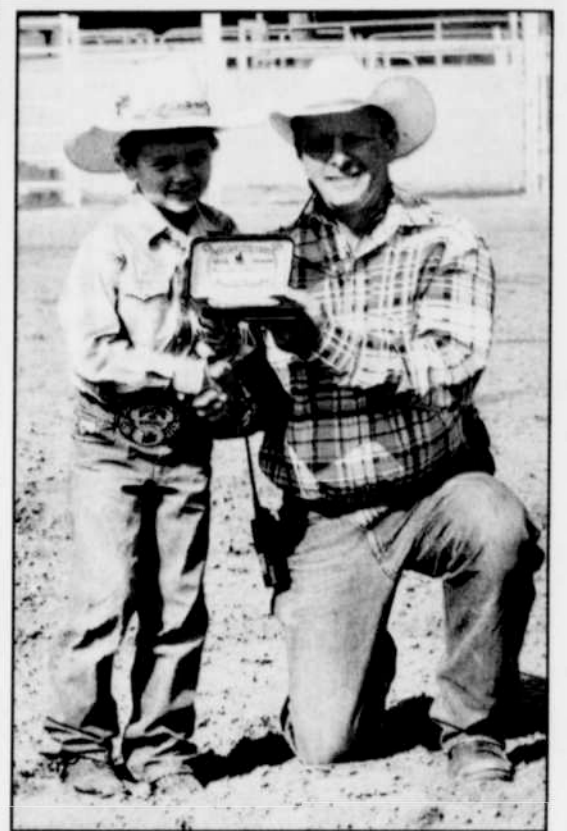
Team Roping winners Jet Stewart and Bo Foster

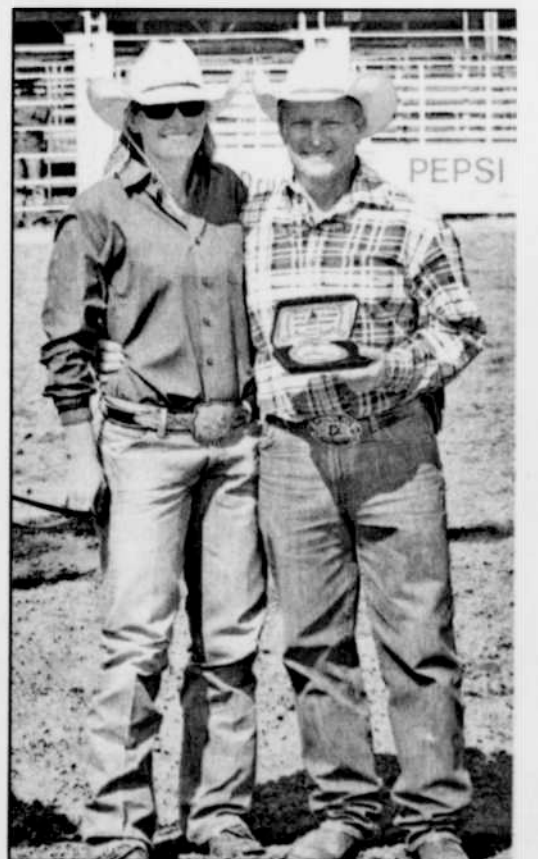
