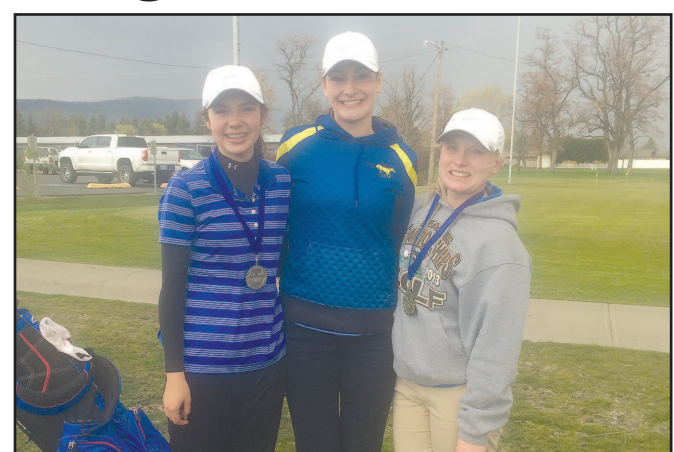
# Mustang girls battle sickness, weather to bring home medals
